### **Timeline assumptions**


ESPR adopted in Q2-Q4 2024

Delegated Act adopted end of 2025

18 months transition to comply in **mid/ end 2027**



### What we expect in 2024

- **Technical inputs** to three JRC consultations
- Work on details, starts new workstreams: implementation, conformity assessment, GPP & Ecolabel, other JRC & EC requests
- Commission renews Ecodesign Forum (presumably after ESPR adoption)


## **EURATEX** on the Textile Delegated Act

#### Overview

- Monitor and advice
- Engaged on a **living** document since **2022**, with technical experts
- Performance requirements based on industry best practices
- Optimal balance between sustainability and competitiveness

- Start with consumer textiles (garments)
- Performance focus on durability, reusability and use of recycled contents
- Information focus on: garment-specific info, who sees what, Enable traceability, how to introduce DPP
- Look at the **bigger picture**: business transition and costs, conformity assessment; enforcement






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
### **Green Claims Directive**

  - Sets criteria. PEFCR for apparel and footwear due in 2025
